We are 70% music and 30% nationally syndicated broadcasts. We don’t charge our broadcasters for air time. Thus, when you give to Missionary Radio, you are supporting us so that we can keep these broadcasts on the air.

This year, Music Director Joe Barner has chosen the theme “Come What May” by We Are Messengers. We feel the message in the song captures what we are all going through. See if you agree.

A Word on the Power Increase for Missionary Radio 91.7 FM in Madisonville

Modifications are underway to increase the power of Missionary Radio 91.7 FM in Madisonville to 6,000 watts. The transmitter is ordered.

We don't have a definitive date when this project will reach fruition. We do know we will have two additional HD frequencies which will give us an opportunity to program two additional Christian formats in the Madisonville area for those who have HD receivers.

We will let you know when we have a firm date and what those additional formats will be.

We will continue to broadcast the same programming on all our frequencies for Missionary Radio, 89.3 FM in Hopkinsville/Fort Campbell/Clarksville, 91.7 FM in Madisonville, 92.1 FM in Murray and 98.9 FM in Dickson, TN.

With the increase in power, plus the two additional HD signals, we have the potential to reach more than 54 thousand more listeners.
